

Guided Tour of Door County Maritime Museum

Located along Sturgeon Bay's working waterfront, this museum showcases the area's rich maritime roots. Hard-working anglers, brave ship captains and lonely lighthouse keepers are some of the personalities you'll discover in the galleries of the museum. In addition, the Jim Kress Maritime Lighthouse Tower features ten floors of interactive educational exhibits that highlight more history.

We will also take a scenic tour atop the 225ft Limestone Bluffs, eat lunch at the English Inn Restaurant - with cherry pie for dessert!
