NIGHT SCHOOL DESCRIPTION, GUIDELINES, AND CALENDAR
2015-16

General Description

The Night School Program was created to allow students to remediate selected courses that are required for graduation in the hopes of allowing students who have fallen behind in credits the chance to graduate on time. Typically, the Night School Program is open to juniors and seniors only and courses can only be taken if they have been failed in the traditional setting. However, the Principal at Chippewa Valley High School and the counselors at Chi-Hi have discretion as to what students are eligible for Night School and what specific courses can be taken.

Sessions

Only one session of Night School will be offered during the 2015-16 school year – during Semester 2. See the calendar on the back of this page for specific dates.

Specific Guidelines

- Only one class in each subject area (Science, Social Studies, English) can be taken.
- Each Session runs for 8 weeks (each class meets one night a week per week) – Students must attend 7 of the 8 weeks to be eligible to earn credit for the course.
- There are both minimum and maximum limits for enrollment in Night School courses. Sessions may be cancelled if numbers are too low. If numbers are too high, students may be placed on a waiting list. **Students need to take advantage of Night School opportunities when they are available.**
- Students are expected to attend the first night of class for a specific session. **If there are students on the waiting list, students who do not attend during the first night of a session may be withdrawn.**
- Night School classes run from 4:15 pm – 7:45 pm including 15 minutes in breaks scheduled at the discretion of the teacher.
- Students will not be allowed into class after 4:30 pm. Students who are late more than once may be withdrawn from the night school session.
- **As the hours required for Night School classes are already at a minimum, excuses for not attending or being late will not be accepted.**
- All Night School classes will be held at Chippewa Valley High School (located on the grounds of the Northern Wisconsin Center). See the CVHS website for a map and directions.
- **If school or afterschool activities are cancelled due inclement weather, Night School classes are also cancelled for that evening and will be rescheduled for a later date.**
