**Combined Ski Trail Distance**

Staghorn + Jack Pine Trails . . . . .	2.75 mi / 4.4 km
Jack Pine to Lake Trail . . . . .	1.7 mi / 2.7 km
Jack Pine to Lake Trail to Red Pine, back to parking on Lake Trail . . . . .	4.0 mi / 6.4 km
Jack Pine to Lake Trail to Red Pine, back on Fox Trail . . . . .	3.6 mi / 5.8 km
Jack Pine to Fox Trail to Red Pine, back on Fox Trail . . . . .	3.1 mi / 5.0 km
Jack Pine to Fox Trail to Red Pine, back on Lake Trail . . . . .	3.4 mi / 5.4 km
