Our Middle School's WEB Drug, Alcohol, and Tobacco Policy

Each selected member of CFMS Middle School's WEB Program understands that the following policy exists. Any inappropriate behavior- including but not exclusively limited to possession of drugs, drug paraphernalia, alcohol, or tobacco; or use of drugs, alcohol, or tobacco- that comes to the WEB Coordinators' attention will result in an immediate review of said behavior and could lead to the leader's removal from the WEB Program.

CFMS's WEB Program has a two-strike system for violating the WEB code of conduct. At first offense, the student is suspended from WEB for 4 weeks. At the end of this suspension, the student may re-apply to WEB. If the student has another offense, he or she is removed from WEB permanently. These strikes accrue for the students' entire time in WEB.

This policy adheres to CFMS Middle School's Student Code of Conduct as well as WEB's philosophy that WEB Leaders "be a presence on campus as models of positive behavior".

As a CFMS Middle School WEB Leader, I understand these policies and the consequences if I choose to violate them. I am aware that failure to adhere to these guidelines may result in my dismissal as a WEB Leader.
