## Campus-wide/ Events

### Be Safe

## Locker Bay

### Be Safe

- Close locker door quietly
- Walk

### Be Respectful

- Maintain personal space

### Be Responsible

- Dispose of litter/trash
- Use your own locker
- Keep electronics turned off and locked up

- Keep locker organized
- Plan ahead
- Take needed materials

## Hallway

### Be Safe

- Walk on the right side
- Walk facing forward

### Be Respectful

- Use quiet voice

- Keep halls clean
- Help others
- Go directly to your destination

### Be Productive

- Be a positive role-model
- Make good choices
- Be on time

## Technology

### Be Safe

- Chromebook lids should always be closed and tightly secured when moving
- Students are required to use their chipfalls.org domain user and password to protect their accounts and are required to keep that password confidential
- Keep personal information to yourself
- All technical support and repairs will be provided by school staff
- Only use your assigned Chromebook

### Be Respectful

- Each student and parent is required to follow the Acceptable Use Policy
- Keep the serial number, factory seal number and asset tag placed on the Chromebook intact
- Chromebooks must remain free of writing, drawing, stickers or etchings

### Be Responsible

- Keep your cell phone and other personal electronics in your locker
- Keep track of your school assigned Chromebook
- Keep the school assigned Chromebook in the carrying case when navigating the hallways
- Return your Chromebook to the assigned area at the end of each school day
- Plug your Chromebook in at the end of the day
- Bring your Chromebook to all classes, unless specifically advised not to do so by your teacher
- Use appropriate language
- Use and search school appropriate material
- Students are responsible for the ethical and educational use of the technology

### Be Productive

- Use technology according to the directions provided by teachers and staff
- Save to the Google Cloud or personal external drives (i.e. thumbdrives)

### Be Safe

- Be respectful of those around you

- Keep noise to a minimum

- Use conversation voice

- Follow adult direction
- Wait for dismissal

## Restroom
