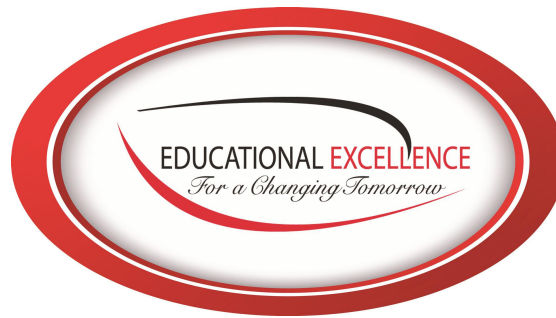
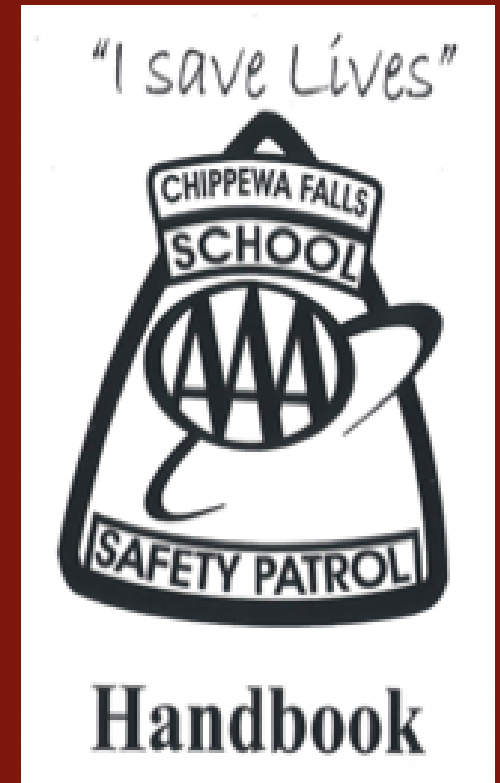


- Be at your post at 7:15am and 2:25pm every day you are scheduled.

Safety Patrol Responsibilities

Post Etiquette

- Always face traffic so you can see vehicles approaching.
- Your flag should be held securely so it is still (no spinning or twirling).
- When no students are crossing, hold your flag in your right hand in the straight up “attention” position.
- When students are crossing, put your flag down to your right at waist height.
- Make sure all students within sight are crossed and safe before leaving your post.

- Safety patrollers should NEVER stop traffic. Wait until there is a “safe gap” in traffic before allowing students to cross.
- Cell phones and other electronic devices are not permitted when on patrol.
- If there is an emergency, one patroller should go find an adult immediately.
- Hillcrest has one set of patrollers on Miles by the front of the school & down by Miles/Wheaton.

Cold Weather Guidelines

We live in an area with cold winters! Here are the guidelines for cold weather:

Zero to -10 degrees:

- Patrols go to their post as usual

-10 to -20 degrees:

- One patrol will be on the island while the other is inside
- Patrols will rotate every 5 minutes

Below -20 degrees:

- Patrols will NOT be at their posts

Please remember to wear appropriate winter gear to set an example for all of the students at our school!
