NEW BUS INFORMATION



The Chippewa Falls Area Unified School District and Chippewa Yellow Bus have been accommodating families with student rerouting requests for over 50 years. A rerouting request is a form that is filled out at the Chippewa Yellow Bus Company and allows a student to ride a bus somewhere other than their home, as long as the request does not add time or distance to the route and 24 hour notice is given. Student rerouting requests continue to grow yearly; to ensure safety of the children please follow these rerouting rules.

- All student rerouting requests originate at the Chippewa Yellow Bus Company. Please contact the Bus Company at 715-726-2454.
- Each family will need to create a consistent weekly schedule for the school year that is in place by August 1, 2021. Parents will be required to provide a calendar identifying dates, or busing will be denied for alternate location. Families should also create an alternate release schedule in the event that school closes early.
- Transportation will be provided to the 4K centers, Tiny Tree Academy, and Boys & Girls Club of the Chippewa Valley when logistically possible.
- Rerouting requests need to stay within the school attendance boundaries. Requests for split families, in-home daycares, and other situations will need to be within the student's school attendance boundary.
- All student rerouting requests require a 24-hour notice and approval by the bus company. This includes one time, or occasional rerouting requests.

Is your child riding the bus?

The Chippewa Yellow Bus Company will send information to your home regarding bus stop locations, morning pick-up times, afternoon drop-off times, and face covering expectations. If you have not received bus information by mid-August or if your address has changed please contact the bus company.

ASSIGNED SEATS: Elementary buses will have the kindergarten students in the front of the bus, first grade behind them, second grade to follow, and so on. The middle/high school routes will have the middle school students in the first half of the bus and the high school students towards the back. As the school year progresses, this may change due to behavior.

TOP 10 BUS RULES

1. Be at the bus stop 5 minutes early.
2. Respect the driver and listen to instructions.
3. Take your seat immediately after boarding the bus.
4. Stay seated at all times.
5. Always get on and off the bus at your stop.
6. Get off the bus carefully, using the handrail.
7. Keep your head, arms, legs, and hands inside the bus.
8. Before crossing the road to get to the bus, be sure to wait for the driver's signal to cross over.
9. Wait for the bus 10 feet off the road or on the sidewalk.
10. Keep away from the bus if you drop or forget something. **Remember the danger zones.**

* Plan to be at your bus stop 5 minutes early * Know your bus number(s) and driver(s) name * Secure your items. Mark with name and bus number * Missed the bus? Call an adult, bus company, or report back to the school (if you are there). * Use a student rerouting request for temporary changes * Contact bus company for permanent changes	* Look out for seat buddy (report sick or injured) * Clean up messes and put trash in the trash can * Report weapons, fighting/threats, or vandalism * Know emergency exits and evacuation plan * Group exit, front to back alternate left to right * Keep food and drink in containers until off the bus or get coach/chaperone approval on charters
