Wednesday	<p>Objective: Students will test their prior knowledge of India &amp; the Indian Subcontinent</p> <p>Classroom Activity: KWL activity and India map pre-test</p> <p>Assignment/Assessment: Prepare for Friday's formative assessment. Indian Subcontinent Map (Due Friday)</p>
Thursday	<p>Objective: Students will improve their knowledge and understanding of the political and physical geography of the Indian Subcontinent.</p> <p>Classroom Activity: Indian Subcontinent Map - class work time.</p> <p>Assignment/Assessment: Prepare for Friday's formative assessment.
