

### How to Find Scholarships

1. **Chi-Hi Scholarship Postings:** Student Services posts the scholarships we receive from organizations. These scholarships are posted throughout the school year on the bulletin board in Student Services. They are also available on the Student Services Website under College Planning – Paying for College.
2. Keep your eye out for **CFAUSD Foundation scholarships** that are for Chi-Hi students only. Students can usually apply for these between Feb. 1 and March 1. The CFAUSD Foundation scholarships will be posted on the scholarship bulletin board.
3. **FastWeb.com:** This is a web-based search engine that will match scholarships to your profile. Answer some questions and the program will find scholarships that you might qualify for, but it's still up to you to apply. There are similar programs available—be cautious of those that require a fee or ask you to create an account.
4. Check with **your or your parent's place of employment, church, clubs, organizations,** etc. Many times these organizations offer scholarship opportunities that are only promoted to its members.
5. **College websites:** Most likely college scholarships will be listed on the Financial Aid page of the college website.
